Archbishop Cupich receives his Pallium

Last Sunday, August 23rd, **Archbishop Blase Cupich** was officially presented his pallium at Holy Name Cathedral by **Archbishop Carlo Maria Vigano**. The pallium is a scarf or vestment blessed by **Pope Francis** that Archbishop Cupich will wear while celebrating Mass. While it has been tradition for the Pope to perform the rite in Rome, Pope Francis decided new bishops should receive the pallium in their home churches.

Archbishop Cupich said in his homily, "*The pallium . . . is a sign of the bond we in Chicago share with the successor of St. Peter.*" Many people at the service mentioned that it was a very beautiful and yet, humble ceremony. Let us please pray for and support Archbishop Cupich as he continues to lead the Archdiocese of Chicago in the way of the Gospel.

Reflecting on God's Word

Is someone in your house going back to school? If so there are books and supplies to buy, schedules to plan, transportation to be arranged. There is the worry over new teachers and whether everything that was learned last year has been forgotten. But no matter. Most of the time the school year begins with a review. That's good because sometimes we understand things better the second or third time we learn them.

With the scriptures this Sunday all of us are going back to school. The series of selections from the Gospel of Mark and the letter of James that we begin this week will teach us one more time what it means to be a disciple. Lucky for us, since most of us can only learn this lesson if we hear and apply it on a daily basis. Today's first reading also instructs us to "hear" and "observe" "the commandments of the Lord . . . that [we] may live" (Deuteronomy 4:1, 2). And the psalm reviews the basics: "The one who does justice will live in the presence of the Lord" (15:1a).

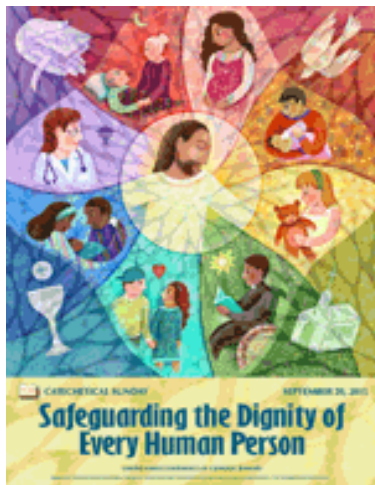

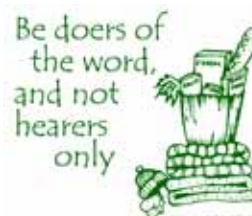
